

Welfare Clinic

The Welfare Clinic provides low cost veterinary care to those unable to afford private veterinary fees.

Owners need to live in the Bradford area and receive a qualifying benefit, pension or be a full-time student living away from home. We provide a full range of veterinary treatments and a vaccination and neutering service.

If you think you may qualify for treatment, please telephone to discuss this with us.

Consultation times are by appointment. We are open Monday to Friday from 9 am to 5 pm.

We also provide veterinary care for the Animal Home and for the RSPCA Inspectors when required. We have to deal with a variety of wildlife and stray animals, from birds of prey to skunks!

The clinic can be very busy and is expensive to run, but we believe we are making a valuable contribution to animal welfare in the Bradford area.

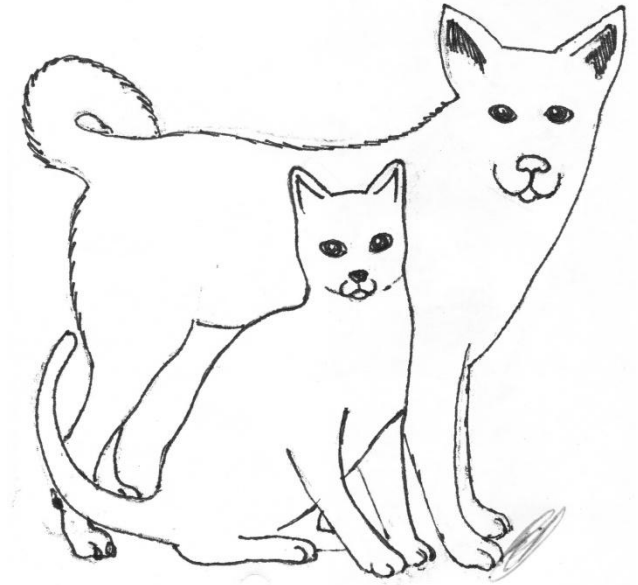

This is a brief introduction to the different areas of the Bradford & District Branch of the RSPCA. We are an independent charity (Registered Charity Number 232211) entirely dependent on public support. All our work is focused on improving animal welfare within the Bradford region

Animal Home

The animal home takes in a wide variety of animals, ranging from domestic pets such as dogs, cats and rabbits to wildlife and farmyard, like hedgehogs and poultry.

Priority is given to stray, sick or injured animals (with the exception of stray dogs with are now the responsibility of the Local Authority), and also to animals whose owners are currently being prosecuted by the RSPCA for cruelty or neglect.

We provide an information and advisory service with trained receptionists available to offer help and advice. We also have a shop selling a range of basic pet supplies and foodstuffs.

The Animal Home is open 6 days a week (closed Thursdays) including Bank Holidays (with the exception of Christmas and New Year).

We offer a Rehoming/Adoption service, with our dedicated dog, cat and small pet teams on hand to find you and your family a suitable pet.

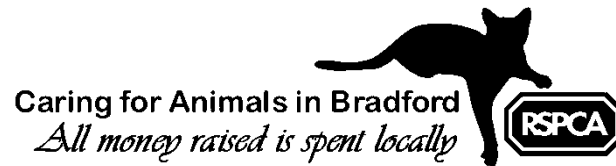
